Days in marked boxes

- 1st 12.b: 6 December 1 CE 12 Wind [6 B Cuicuilco = 1 B Olmec = 5 B Izapa = 5 B or Yaxk'in Tikal] (1721765): name day; New Year
- 1st 13.g: 21 March 2 CE 13 Deer [6 G Cuicuilco = 6 G Olmec = 5 G Izapa = 10 G or Kej Tikal] (1721870): spring equinox; New Year+105 days
- 1st 2.t: 22 June 2 CE 2 Lord [19 K Cuicuilco = 19 K Olmec = 18 K Izapa = 3 L or K'ayab' Tikal] (1721963): summer solstice
- 2nd 12.b: 23 August 2 CE 12 Wind [1 O Cuicuilco = 1 O Olmec = 0 O Izapa = 0 O or Wo Tikal] (1722025): name day; little New Year

Consecutive days in the 260-day calendar are listed within the cells of the calendar.

Each year in this calendar is initially named. Type II year bearers are indicated: Wind, Deer, Jaw, Quake.

Each day of the month numbered 0 in this calendar probably was known anciently as the "seating" or beginning of the month and it was followed with the 19 numbered days of that month. The use of 0 is a modern convention to represent the "seating" day.

The listed dates use a more recent spelling of Tikal month names than that used by Edmonson.
